2. The Terms of References (ToRs) of the Committee are as under: -

- Endorse the overall vision, guiding principles, and strategic direction of the Curriculum rationalisation and optimisation process, ensuring alignment with national education policies, international commitments and provisions of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- Provide high-level oversight of the Curriculum rationalisation and optimisation process, including adherence to agreed procedures, sequencing, timelines, and consultative approaches.
- Ensure effective federal–provincial coordination, safeguarding meaningful participation of Provinces and Areas and ensuring that contextual needs and implementation realities inform key decisions.

- iv) Endorse key reform outputs for approval and phased implementation, including the National Curriculum Framework, Scheme of Studies, subject curricula, and cross-cutting thematic integrations, while overseeing strategic risks and resource implications.
- v) The Committee shall receive progress briefs and technical recommendations from the Technical Committee and shall issue formal decisions, approvals and directives as required.
- vi) The Committee shall meet at least once quarterly, or additionally as required at critical reform milestones.
