NOTIFICATION

No.F.1-2/2022/AEA(Sc): The Competent Authority i.e. Secretary, Ministry of Federal Education and Professional Training (MoFE&PT) has been pleased to approve the *Religious Education (RE) Curriculum 2023* for Grades 1-12, in lieu of Islamiyat (Compulsory), for citizens belonging to religions other than Islam. Specifically, Religious Education Curriculum has been developed for seven religions, namely Bahai, Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Kalasha, Sikhism and Zoroastrianism. Curriculum standards have been developed and reviewed by the Religious Education Experts (of the concerned religion) from across the country under National Curriculum of Pakistan (NCP 2022-23).

2. The Religious Education Curriculum is available on the websites www.mofept.gov.pk & ncc.gov.pk and will be implemented in all the public and private educational institutions of Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) and the educational institutions under Federal Government across the country. The Religious Education Curriculum for Grades 1-12 will be implemented from the Academic Year 2025, replacing the subject of Ethics.
