GUIDELINES FOR ELECTIVE MEDICAL & HEALTH SCIENCES GROUP FOR GRADES XI-XII

- i) The eligibility criteria to join this group is matriculation with a science background.
- ii) Elective subjects (Theory and Lab) will be divided as 40% for theory and 60% for practical for technical education stream and/or skill-based.
- iii) Students will appear in 03 compulsory subjects per grade in XI-XII. Students will either choose 03 subjects from a specified Group or as specified by the institution on the availability of faculty/resources.
- iv) In cases where students want to choose subject(s) beyond those specified in the group, they may opt for additional subject(s) totaling 200 marks in case of grade XI-XII from any group.
- v) The additional subject(s) involving practical, a student will provide a Practical Performance Certificate to the respective Board. For additional subject(s), the students may make personal arrangements for their study.
- vi) The marks of additional subject(s) will not be part of the total marks of the Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC) (1100). The examination board will issue a separate transcript for the additional subject(s).
- vii) Passport Holders / Students not studying under Pakistan Education Boards will study Pakistani culture in Grades XI-XII in lieu of Urdu.
- viii) Total College time per day may be 5-5.30 hours. Time allocation for each subject may be decided at an institutional level.
- ix) Academic sessions for Grades XI-XII in Summer & Winter zones will be started in the first week of August.
- x) Summer & Winter Vacation announcements are at the discretion of the administrative departments of respective educational institutions.
